THE WINE

- 61% Merlot, 39% Cabernet Franc
- Harvested late September to early October at 24.2 - 25.5 brix
- Crop size: 2.20-3.30 tons/acre
- Hand sorted and lightly crushed
- Native fermented
- Average length on skins was 14 days
- Pressed directly to barrel (barrique format): 100% French, 30% new
- Racked only twice throughout its 20 month maturation
- Bottled unfinned and unfiltered in June, 2013
- 640 cases produced

- Angela's Vineyard – EFESTÉ Estate

- pH 3.89
- TA 5.4g/L

TASTING NOTES

At 61% Merlot and 39% Cabernet Franc, the 2011 Nana is truly a Right Bank Bordeaux blend. Aromas of blackberry extract, blueberry, plum, asphalt, dark chocolate, tea leaf, baked herbs and ripe cigar tobacco jump from the glass. The wine is silky and rich on the approach with well integrated tannins and a firm, young finish. This vintage of Nana is well framed and has miles to run before reaching its summit of maturity.
