This off-dry Riesling balances mouthwatering acidity, chalky minerality, and bright orchard fruit, making it a versatile favorite.

Feral Sauvignon Blanc embodies the untamed spirit of its varietal, with a name that translates to “in a wild state.” This 100% Sauvignon Blanc from the Evergreen Vineyard is a tribute to EFESTĒ’s commitment to native, or “wild,” fermentation. The result is a powerhouse of clean, focused flavors, showcasing the vibrant minerality and crisp acidity of the Ancient Lakes AVA.

Lola Chardonnay is a tribute to the youthful elegance of the Ferrelli family's granddaughter, symbolizing vibrancy and grace. Initially crafted with fruit from the cooler Ancient Lakes AVA, Lola now hails from the warmer Wahluke Slope, enhancing its depth while retaining the crisp acidity and minerality it is known for. By blending concrete fermentation and large oak puncheons, Lola achieves a refined balance of tropical fruit, citrus, and a hint of creaminess.

About the Wine

Every family has a term of endearment for their matriarch, and for EFESTĒ, Nana is a tribute to Daniel Ferrelli's grandmother, Jenny Ferrelli. This Bordeaux-style red blend, crafted from Merlot and Cabernet Franc sourced from the Red Willow Vineyard in the Yakima Valley AVA, reflects the warmth, care, and legacy of grandmothers everywhere. Styled after the right-bank Bordeaux region, Nana highlights the tart acidity and vibrant ruby color of Cabernet Franc, paired with the softer, spiced edges of Merlot for a wine that is both elegant and comforting.

About the Wine

Tough Guy Red Blend is named in honor of a young leukemia survivor who showed unwavering resilience during his battle. In support of the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society, a portion of proceeds from each bottle helps fund ongoing research and patient care. This deeply layered blend—often featuring Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot—captures bold black fruit flavors, tobacco notes, and a classic tannin structure, reflecting Red Mountain's signature intensity.

Produced from 2008 through 2018 exclusively for Wine Club members, Emmy Red Blend is crafted from Mourvèdre, Grenache, and Syrah, highlighting the dark, extracted raspberry notes of Syrah and the peppery, savory character of Mourvèdre. Although now retired, Emmy remains a cherished library wine—versatile enough to complement everything from grilled or gamey meats to charcuterie and cheese plates.

Ceidleigh Syrah (pronounced “kay-lee”) is inspired by a memorable encounter in Australia. “Ceidleigh” is a Gaelic term referring to a traditional Scottish or Irish social gathering filled with music and dancing. This 100% Syrah is often called our “Goldilocks” Syrah—exceptionally balanced, with ripe red bramble fruit, earthy undertones, and a rich full body. Its vibrant character makes it perfect for grilling season and gatherings.

About the Wine

Taking its name from the French phrase for “pretty mouth,” Jolie Bouche Syrah begins its journey in the exceptional Boushey Vineyards—renowned for producing expressive, high-quality Syrah in Washington State. Crafted entirely from 100% Syrah, this wine boasts ultra-concentrated color, aroma, and flavor. With minimal intervention, native fermentation, and careful aging, Jolie Bouche emerges as a deep, brooding Syrah characterized by elegance and a “pretty” silky texture.

Eléni Syrah is the crown jewel of EFESTĒ's Syrah collection. Sourced from Washington's oldest Syrah vines at Red Willow Vineyard, this 100% Syrah honors EFESTĒ Owner Helen "Eléni" Ferrelli, who has supported her family's winemaking journey from the very beginning. Named after Helen's given Greek name—meaning "light" or "torch"—Eléni Syrah combines depth, richness, and elegance to reflect both the family's heritage and Red Willow Vineyard's outstanding terroir.

About the Wine

At EFESTÉ, we discovered that this traditionally blending variety truly shines on its own. Sourced from our low-elevation Taylor Mag Vineyard on Red Mountain, this 100% Petit Verdot undergoes spontaneous fermentation with native yeasts, then ages 20 months in French oak (60% new) before bottling unfinned and unfiltered. The result is a bold, dark-fruited expression of Red Mountain's terroir, reflecting EFESTÉ's minimalistic and quality-driven approach.
